S.P. McCarl successfully installed over \$3 million worth of ductwork, piping and plumbing for the new Procter and Gamble plant in West Virginia. The plant is nearly 2.5 million square feet state-of-the-art mega factory. The total cost of the plant was roughly \$500 million with a total of 485 acres. Cleaning products, shampoos, washes and soaps will be manufactured by robotics.

The total amount of ductwork was roughly 10,000 ft, process piping another 7,000 ft, and laboratory plumbing roughly 8,000 ft.

Safety and logistics were crucial for this project. With over 3,000 tradesmen on site, shipments needed to be carefully coordinated and executed to keep the project running smoothly.
